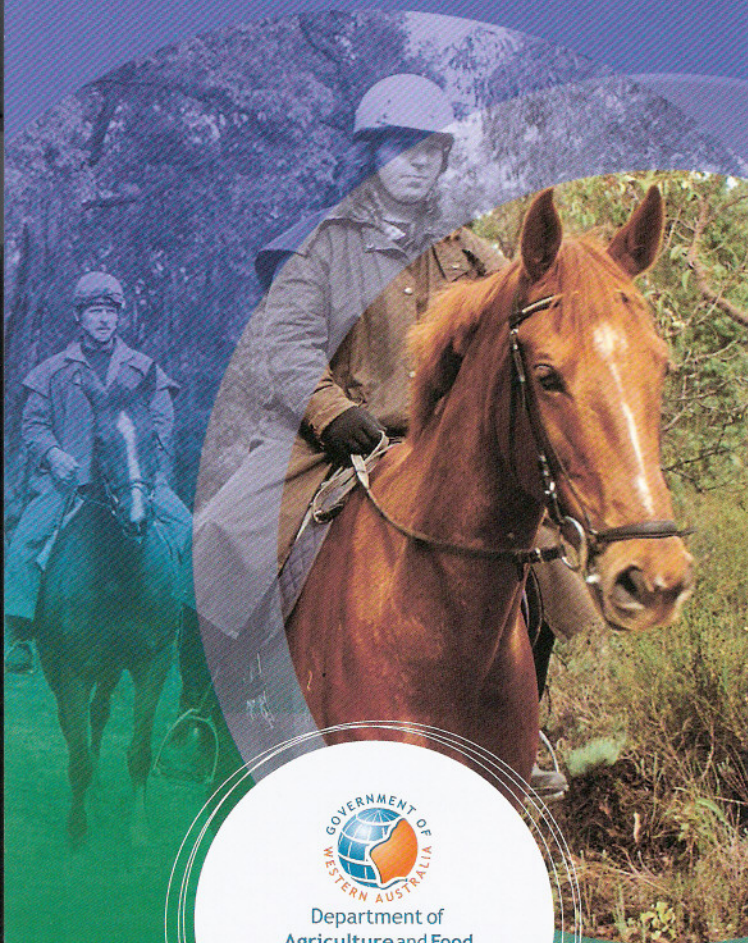


KEEP equine influenza OUT of Western Australia

Equine influenza virus can survive for 48 hours on your skin, hair, clothing, footwear and equipment.

If you have been near any horse, pony, donkey or mule in another State recently you may be carrying the virus. Before you go near any horse, pony, donkey or mule in Western Australia, tell the owner. Please take the following precautions immediately.

- Shower thoroughly and wash your hair.
- Wash or dry-clean all clothing and accessories you were wearing or carrying when near the horse.
- Disinfect your footwear with household disinfectant or bleach and hot water. Read the disinfectant or bleach label carefully and follow the instructions.

Do not bring any riding equipment or horse accessories into Western Australia.

Equine influenza poses no threat to people.
