

Growth Corridor Development

The strategy for the development of infrastructure in the Swan urban growth corridor will be tabled before Council this May.

The City of Swan has been working closely with the Department of Planning and Infrastructure to develop the sub-regional plan. The City has also undertaken extensive consultation with developers to establish a strategy for the provision of infrastructure in the corridor.

The strategy will address the most equitable method of cost sharing to fund a number of projects in the future. The larger projects which are identified by the strategy include:

- Construction of Henley Brook Avenue, between Park Street and Reid Highway.
- Extension of Marshall Road to the new Henley Brook Avenue.
- Extension of Lord Street between Reid Highway and Benara Road in Caversham.
- Construction of a bridge taking Arthur Street over Reid Highway.
- Acquisition of land for the development of playing fields in West Swan.
